Ice Conditions

Our first goal as a new Board was securing a qualified ice technician. We are very fortunate that Ice Technician, Level 2, Brittni Fernandes, has joined our team. She has been working tirelessly over the last two weeks, often late into the night or early morning, to get the ice prepared for us. Brittni has been getting to know our facility and has already made some technical changes to create the best possible ice. We are fortunate to have Brittni with us so please welcome her to our curling family.

Ice Chair Position

Dan Sutherland has stepped into the role of *Ice Chair*. Dan will focus on helping Brittni with ice operations and maintenance and act as the primary contact for her. If you have a question or concern related to the ice, please talk to Dan. This will free up Brittni to focus on ice maintenance and conditions. We've posted the Ice Chair position description on our website under the "Club Policies" menu.

Chester Ice Technician Volunteers

As part of our efforts to create optimum ice conditions, on November 22 and 23 Brittni will be conducting in-house training for the volunteers that help prepare ice for our daily leagues. Starting at 7:00 pm, she will show the techniques, equipment and safety procedures to follow in support of the ice conditions she is striving to obtain. If you are part of this team, please plan on attending one of these sessions.

Scheduled Practice Ice

Sometimes there are individuals or teams that wish to practice. To facilitate optimum ice conditions with consistent preparation and safety for all curlers, we have implemented four blocks in the schedule where Brittni will prepare

the ice and be on-hand to monitor and adjust conditions. All members have access to these practice blocks of times through the on-line booking process on a first-come-first-serve basis. Four times weekly (Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Sunday), Brittni will prepare and be present for two-hour blocks of practice ice

time. Soon, the *Practice Ice Guidelines* and *Ice Booking and Club Rental Policy* will be posted on our website under the "Club Policies" tab.

League Fees / Financial Update

As you likely know, our club revenue relies primarily on membership dues. This is presenting a challenge with increasing operational costs in almost all areas. Last year, we were able to balance the books overall, but we are experiencing several new budget pressures for this year that require increased membership fees as well as some other revenue generation initiatives. Our rent has increased by 10% and we have increased the hourly pay rate and the number of hours for our ice technician to attract the best possible candidate and to ensure quality ice for the entire season. If we were to make up the anticipated deficit solely through membership fee increases, then we would have to increase fees by an estimated 22%, or at least double what the increase is this season. The Board feels that such an increase would be detrimental to retaining current members and attracting new ones,

so we have decided that a 10% increase is warranted and that new measures will be made to increase revenue of other types to address the potential deficient at the end of the year.

Revenue Generation and Innovation

To diversify our income, we've established a new committee chair, the *Revenue Generation and Innovation Chair*. New club member, Shane Langille, has stepped up to lead this critical initiative. The longevity of our Club and curling in Chester depends on a strong revenue generation effort because membership dues currently do not cover expenses. Besides securing current and new sponsorship (the signs in the ice shed), Shane will be identifying sources of grants, other potential revenue streams, innovative approaches for growth, social activities and ways to attract and retain members.
