The best way to register for the 2023-24 season is online at www.chestercurlingclub.ca (under Curling>Membership>Registration Process). The membership and other fees are provided in the table to the left and a detailed description of each category is available on the website under the Curling>Membership tab. If you register online before October 20, you will be placed in a draw for a chance to win a rebate of 50% of your membership fee.

Last year we introduced the ability to pay for your membership fee using VISA or Mastercard as part of the online registration process and it is being continued this year as it was very popular with members. If you do not use this option, then etransfer, cheque and cash will be available as in previous years.

If you are unable to use the online system for any reason, you may also register and pay in person on Mon-Fri Oct 16-20 – 7:15 to 9 pm at the Curling Club or during the first week of league play during the following

week. The ice will be ready so bring along your equipment to try it out while you're there.

Another feature that was introduced last year was that you will no longer be required to submit a signed paper copy of the waiver form at registration. When you register online you will be asked to acknowledge that you have read and agree to all the terms and conditions on the waiver form stored on the website. Due to the security features of the website, this will have the same legal standing of the paper forms.

Please note that NO league play is permitted until a player is registered, all waivers are acknowledged, and fees are paid in full.

<u>Lockers</u>...Lockers will be available this year and members are encouraged to pay their locker fee as part of the registration process.

<u>Club 200</u>...We ask for your support for the Club 200 fundraiser initiative. The price is \$20 per ticket; just add payment for your ticket (s) with your registration. **Please note: Club 200 tickets are available to anyone, not just to curlers.** Please email <u>info@chestercurlingclub.ca</u> and we will ensure appropriate payment and ticket delivery arrangements.
